The 3 Types of Data Backups

Full Backup

- Copies everything on your system in a single location.
- Quick and easy to restore.
- More costly method as it requires more storage.



Incremental Backup

- Saves only the changes made since the last backup.
- Ideal for frequent backups.
- Longer recovery time since more files need to be accessed.



Differential Backup

- Saves all changes made since the last full backup.
- Restores faster than incremental backups.
- Restoration is slow and complex, and backup takes longer.
